## Pre-K Readiness (Entering Kindergarten in the Fall)

Prepares the child with the necessary handwriting and visual-perceptual readiness to succeed. This multisensory program uses clay, foam, finger painting, chalkboards, dry-erase boards, and wooden pieces to make letters. We encourage awareness of patterns through colors, shapes, and letters; we use tactile materials for increasing discriminative sense, and a sensory gym to build proximal strength for the stability required of the trunk when fingers are being used in dexterity tasks. We will also use handgrip strengthening exercises for writing endurance.

## Handwriting Success (1<sup>st</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> graders)

This program is intended for children that are having difficulty with handwriting and would benefit from an intensive 12-session program. We will use a multisensory, and sensori-motor based approach to achieve success in handwriting tasks. By preparing the child's entire body for the writing task, handwriting can become less demanding for the child.

## Elementary School Story Writing (1<sup>st</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> graders)

In this group, we will focus on writing legibility and also on the writing process. We will focus on sequencing thoughts into handwriting and developing the concepts of beginning, middle and end. This program is intended for children that are having difficulty in content writing. Sensory Kids will have a school teacher with writing expertise and an Occupational Therapist to assist with any sensory / fine motor needs that the children might have.
